

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
CITY OF JOHNSON CITY
NOVEMBER 18, 2025

Mayor Vince Whitehead called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. and led the flag salute.

Mayor Vince Whitehead and Councilors Margaret McCrea, Mike Tranquilla, and Jackie Moritz were present. Councilor Luan Evans was absent.

Mayor Vince Whitehead welcomed everyone to the meeting and read the rules of order (a copy of which is attached to the official minutes). He also announced that the meeting is being recorded and on Zoom. Mayor Vince Whitehead led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Consent Agenda

Minutes for the September 2025 meeting were presented. Motion was made by Councilor Margaret McCrea, seconded by Councilor Jackie Moritz, to approve the minutes as presented. An audience member stated that the date on the minutes should have been August not September and requested that the council members take a public meetings law class.

Harvest Station Review: Mayor Vince Whitehead stated that Harvest Station went well and was enjoyed by those who attended.

Mayor Vince Whitehead reported that the city website should be ready for a December 1st launch. After discussion of its status, motion was made by Mike Tranquilla, seconded by Jackie Moritz, to push the website launch back to January 1st to allow more time for testing. Motion passed unanimously.

Operation Santa Planning: Mayor Vince Whitehead reported that plans are for the city to participate in the fire district's Operation Santa food and toy drive for the holidays. A resident suggested that the donations by residents be distributed in Johnson City rather than going to the fire department for distribution. It was pointed out that the city has no way of determining need within the city and that the county has that all set up. Motion was made by Councilor Margaret McCrea, seconded by Councilor Mike Tranquilla, to participate in Operation Santa with \$500 for food and ~~\$500~~ \$300 for toys. Motion passed unanimously. Jackie Moritz and Mike Tranquilla volunteered to do the shopping. Jack Moritz and Mike Tranquilla set up a bicycle safety event with the sheriff's office and Mike Tranquilla offered to help her if she wishes.

Motion was made by Margaret McCrea, seconded by Jackie Moritz, to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed unanimously.
