Johnson City Council Meeting

Minutes, May 20, 2025

Opening: The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Vince Whitehead. The Council and attendees stood for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mayor Whitehead called roll. In attendance were Council Members Jacqueline Moritz, Margaret McCrea, Mayor Whitehead and City Recorder Judy Davis. Council Member Randy Anderson did not attend.

Approval of April Minutes: The Council took time to review the minutes of the April City Council Meeting. Jacqueline Moritz moved to adopt the minutes as presented; Margaret McCrea seconded the Motion. Mayor Whitehead called for a vote. Mayor Whitehead voted aye; Jacqueline Moritz voted aye; Margaret McCrea voted aye. There were no Nay votes.

Financial Statements: No financial statements were presented to the Council. City Recorder Davis affirmed that she will present a set of financial statements, to cover the months that none have been presented, at the June City Council meeting.

Applications for open City Council position: Two people were interviewed for the vacancy created by the resignation of Council Member Angie Long. Both Tara Schoffstall and Luan Evans were interviewed for the position. The Council did not vote on the

appointment, as the application period is open until June 6. The appointment will be made at the June Council meeting.

Application for Planning Commission: The Council interviewed Dorothy Malson for the vacancy on the Planning Commission. Jacqueline Moritz moved to accept Ms. Malson's application for the position; Margaret McCrea seconded the Motion. Mayor Whitehead called for a vote. Mayor Whitehead voted aye; Jacqueline Moritz voted aye; Margaret McCrea voted aye. There were no Nay votes.

Kay Mordock and Dean _____ then applied to renew their positions on the Planning Commission. Jacqueline Moritz moved to accept both applications for renewal of their positions on the Planning Commission; Margaret McCrea seconded the Motion. Mayor Whitehead called for a vote. Mayor Whitehead voted aye; Jacqueline Moritz voted aye; Margaret McCrea voted aye. There were no Nay votes.

Mayor Whitehead then administered the Oath of Office to Dorothy Malson, Kay Mordock and Dean _____ for the Planning Commission terms of two years.

Website Development: Mayor Whitehead announced that he has added Jacqueline Moritz to the Website Committee, which has met once since the appointment. Council Member Margaret McCrea gave a brief report on the current state of progress toward obtaining a website for Johnson City. There was some discussion about how to find the developer of the "unofficial" site currently on the Internet. City Recorder Davis said she will find his address so Council Member Margaret McCrea can send him a letter.

Mayor Whitehead has created a timeline for the project and requests that Committee Members Jacqueline Moritz and Margaret McCrea present their findings, analysis and recommendations regarding selecting a website developer and webhost for the City, along with the costs associated with each of the options at the June Council meeting.

Replacing the old flags: Jacqueline Moritz offered to order new flags for the City, as she had pointed out at the last meeting that they were in poor shape, and Mayor Whitehead had said that the City had money in its budget to purchase them. Ms. Moritz asked for the catalog from our supplier, but City Recorder Davis said that she would order new flags, a task that she has done several times in the past and which has been postponed during the time that she has been not working.

Adjournment: Jacqueline Moritz moved to adjourn the meeting; Margaret McCrea seconded the Motion. Mayor Whitehead called for a vote. Mayor Whitehead voted aye; Jacqueline Moritz voted aye; Margaret McCrea voted aye. There were no Nay votes.
